#### **General Rules and Guidelines for Competition:**

- 1. Maximum number of participants in a team is 2.
- 2. Abstract should not exceed more than 250 words and Paper should not exceed 15 pages.
- 3. The front page of paper should be consisting of participant's / team member's names, contact no., email id, college name and title at the top of page.
- 4. Bring your college I-Card & receipt on event day.
- 5. Kindly bring your Power Point presentation on a CD or on a pen-drive.
- 6. Soft-copies of the submitted pdf and power point presentations PPT.
- 7. Kindly Mail your abstract, paper and PPT to <u>innovisionejpoly2k24@gmail.com</u>.
- 8. Difficulties will be addressed through the same email-id.
- 9. The teams will get 10 minutes for presentation and followed by question and answer session for 5 minutes.

#### 10. The mail with submissions should contain:

Title- theme of the paper. Names of the authors.

Phone no of the authors. E-mail ID's.

- i. Paper should be in IEEE Format.
- ii. Paper must contain index, list of figures, list of tables, abstract, introduction, point wise description of subject and conclusion, Result and references.
- iii. Paper must be preceded by a cover page specifying the title of the paper, names of authors and their college names as also their contact numbers and email ids.
- iv. Last day to submit soft copy of your paper (via e-mail) is 15 March, 2024.
- v. After you have submitted the soft copy, a panel of judges will go through your material and if you are shortlisted to give the presentation, you will be notified.
- vi. The abstract mail should contain abstract, references, your e-mail id and mobile number.
- vii. The decision of judges will be final and no arguments or appeal will be entertained.

- b. Subject Analysis
- c. Innovative Ideas, originality and creativity
- d. Inclusion of Audio/ Video effects, exceptional use of power point
